## Kids Club Childcare Programs

After a transitional period over the last 18 months, EPR District has now received its license for Running Creek and has assumed full management of Kids Club programming at both the Singing Hills and Running Creek Elementary School sites from the Elizabeth School District. While the School District will continue its focus on serving youth and families during the school day, EPR is proud to focus on providing needed childcare services during “out of school time”. Programs offered at both sites include before school care beginning at 6:30am and continuing until the start of the school day, after school care beginning at the conclusion of the school day until 6pm, and day camps during Fall Break, Spring Break, and for 10 weeks over the summer. Before school care is \$13/day, after school care is \$15/day, and full-day camps are \$55/day.

Our goal is to provide dependable high-quality childcare for community youth while keeping costs as affordable as we can for families. With the recent hiring of a full-time Childcare Programs Coordinator, we look forward to raising the bar by improving program consistency, increasing training and development for staff, improving program communications, and bumping up the fun factor for the kiddos.

All Kids Club programming is licensed by the Colorado Department of Early Childhood and therefore require the completion and submission of a registration packet. # Help Support Local Parks and Recreation Sponsorship Opportunities Available

The District offers several opportunities for local businesses and organizations to help support community recreation. ## Prime Field Sponsorship

Prime Field Sponsorship includes naming rights for the new artificial turf ballfield within Casey Jones Park. Prime Field Sponsors receive naming rights of the field on site and on the District website, as well as other District composed content. The cost for Prime Field Sponsorship is \$2500 and includes the initial cost of banners.

## Prime Court Sponsorship

Prime Court Sponsorship includes naming rights for one of the four new pickleball courts within Casey Jones Park. Four Prime Court Sponsorships are available, and sponsorship covers a one-year period beginning from the date the sponsorship is purchased. Prime Court Sponsors receive naming rights of a court on-site and on the District website, as well as other District composed content. The cost for Prime Court Sponsorship is \$625 and includes the initial cost of banners.

## Fans of the Field Sponsorship

Fans of the Field Sponsorships include the right to display a banner (up to 40 square feet) on the outfield fence of the new artificial turf field in Casey Jones Park. The cost for Fans of the Field Sponsorship is \$500 and includes the initial cost of banners.
